CLASS A: Grammy's Hugs and Kisses (90" x 100") Definitely a "Beautiful No Brainer". (Every BNB pattern is designed to teach a clever way of solving a typical quilters' problem and doing it in a way that's elegantly simple and always effective.) It produces a great result and eliminates sewing any bias seams. That's right, there are no bias seams because our construction method deals only with squares. Taught by Maggie O'Reilly

CLASS B: Fringy-Edged Applique Stars (52" x 67") This is a fun and easy quilt to make with your machine. You don't have to worry about matching seams or fabrics! If your stars are off, it just adds character. After it is all quilted, throw it into the washer and dryer so the edges of the stars will fray and give it a "fringy" look.
